What you should know before visiting as part of a small-group rental booking:

We are committed to keeping our visitors and our community healthy. With this in mind, the following procedures and rules are currently in place:

Please bring these with you to the museum:

- **A mask.** Masks are required for all guests ages two and over, in all areas of the museum. If you cannot wear a mask we encourage you to wear a face shield; these are available for a small fee at the museum.
- **A health release.** We ask that all guests arrive with the attached form, or complete this form when they arrive. This form includes a self-health check as well as information needed by the Health Department for contact tracing. All forms will be destroyed after two weeks.

During your visit, the following rules and policies are in place to keep everyone safe:

- Food and drinks, with the exception of water, are not allowed in the museum
- Drinking fountains will be disabled
- All guests must wear masks at all times. If you have an individual in your party who cannot wear a mask, we do have a limited number of face shields for sale.

For your safety:

- Hand sanitizer stations are placed throughout the museum
- Staff will be cleaning high-touch surfaces throughout your visit. The museum and all exhibits and toys are cleaned and disinfected thoroughly after each rental using non-toxic materials shown to kill the COVID virus
- Selected exhibit components are not currently available due to COVID-related restrictions. Notable changes are as follows:
 - Costumes, dolls, stethoscopes, and fabric and plush toys have been removed
 - Kinetic sand has been removed from the sand table
 - Books and bean bags have been removed; the hayloft (reading area and flying pic interactive) is closed

- Do you have a fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher?
- Do you have a cough?
- Do you have a sore throat?
- Have you been experiencing difficulty breathing or a shortness of breath?
- Do you have muscle aches?
- Have you had a new or unusual headache (e.g., not typical to the individual)?
- Have you noticed a new loss of taste or loss of smell?
- Have you been experiencing chills or rigors (i.e., a sudden feeling of cold with shivering accompanied by a rise in temperature)?
- Do you have any gastrointestinal concerns (e.g., abdominal, pain, vomiting, diarrhea)?
- Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Is anyone in your household displaying any symptoms (as listed above) of COVID-19?
- To the best of your knowledge, in the last 14 days, have you come into close contact with anyone who has tested positive for or been diagnosed with COVID-19?
